Terms of the proficiency test (PT)

DLA ptALS3 (2025) Allergen-Screening III - 4 Samples qualitative: Celery (Leaves / Stem, Root and Seed), **Cereals containing Gluten** (Wheat or Rye and Barley or Oat), **Lupin, Peanut, Sesame** (white and black) (New: test of Action Levels included)

Test material*:

There are 4 different samples possibly containing the allergenic parameters Celery (Leaves/Stem, Root and Seed), Cereals containing Gluten (Wheat or Rye and Barley or Oat), Peanut, Lupin and Sesame (white and black) for qualitative determination.

NEW: The allergens are contained in a simple food matrix (rice flour / maltodextrin) and all parameters are contained in 2 of 4 samples providing 2/3 and 1/6 of the new Action Levels (VITAL 4.0, 2024), respectively. The "action level" in mg/kg is calculated from the allergen protein reference dose per 100 g food portion. The positive detection of the 2/3 action level ensures that the action level can be detected safely even when the measurement uncertainty of the applied method is about 50%. While the 1/6 action level can proof the method performance at lower levels close to the LOQ.

Sample weight: 4 samples 20 g each.

* Note: Qualitative tests and testing of the content, homogeneity and stability of PT parameters are carried out by DLA. Additional tests can be subcontracted by DLA.

Methods + realisation time:

The analytical methods **ELISA** (+ **Lateral Flow**), **PCR** (+ **NGS**) and **LC/MS** can be applied for qualitative determinations.

There is a 6 weeks period for performing the analysis. The results are transmitted online via our customer portal.

Evaluation report:

The **evaluation** is carried out **strictly qualitatively** (positive/negative) with indication of the obtained agreements with the consensus values of the participants and the spiking of samples 1-4.

All results including quantitative results, limits of detection and/or quantification and remarks to the methods will be documented. DLA intends to finish the evaluation report within 6 weeks after deadline of results submission. Each participant receives an

anonymized, complete evaluation report as a PDF-file, identifying the own results by individual code in case payment was done and can object in writing to the evaluation within 6 weeks.

Registration:

Shipment + number of participants:

Required minimum number of participants is 10. The samples will be sent to participants on **2025-10-08.** by parcel service with tracking (delivery time 2-5 days within Europe, 2-10 days worldwide).

Deadline of result submission:

Last date for submission of results 2025-11-21.

Invoice + price :

Invoicing will be done by DLA along with the sample shipment or by our authorized partner in parallel to the sample shipment. The price for the proficiency test is 390 € (participation with one method) and 460 € (participation with two or more methods) per participant plus shipping and tax.

Costs for double sample material € 90,00.
